Judge: Preparation:

- Set a table with five chars for competing team members.
- Provide a copy of the problem instructions for <u>PART 1, ONLY</u> on the table for the team members.

Judge Instructions PART 1:

(Judge: When team members enter the room, tell them)

This is a verbal challenge. You have 1 minute to select the five team members who will compete. The others must sit in these seats and watch or be escorted from the room. They may not assist in solving the problem and may not talk.

(Judge: After 5 Team Members Chosen and seated, Read all the instructions, repeat, then Start the Time)

1. This is a two part problem...after you complete part 1, you will receive instructions for part 2.

PART 1

- 2. You will have 1 minute to think and 3 minutes to respond. You may ask questions; however, time will continue. Do not talk to each other at any time
- 3. You will receive 1 point for each ordinary response and 3 points for each creative response.
- 4. Once time begins, it will not be stopped, even if a judge asks you to repeat a response, clarify it, or give a more appropriate response. Speak loudly and clearly.
- 5. Your team will respond in the order that you are seated. You may not skip your turn, repeat an answer or pass. If one member of your team is stuck, then the others must wait for that team member to answer.
- 6. Your challenge is to name as many things that Ring as you can, or say the word Ring in a sentence. For example you might say "Was that the doorbell ringing?", or "We are sitting in a ring.".

(Judge: After Part 1 is completee)

Provide a copy of the problem instructions for <u>PART 2</u> on the table for the team members.

(Judge: After 5 Team Members Chosen and seated, Read all the instructions, repeat, then Start the Time)

PART 2

- 1. You will have 1 minute to think and 3 minutes to respond. You may ask questions; however, time will continue. Do not talk to each other at any time
- 2. You will receive 1 point for each ordinary response and 9 points for each creative response.
- 3. Once time begins, it will not be stopped, even if a judge asks you to repeat a response, clarify it, or give a more appropriate response. Speak loudly and clearly.
- 4. Your team will respond in the order that you are seated. You may not skip your turn, repeat an answer or pass. If one member of your team is stuck, then the others must wait for that team member to answer. You may each take two turns, once each team member has had two turns, the problem is over, even if more time remains.
- 5. Your challenge is to name as many things that Ring as you can, or say the word Ring in a sentence. For example you might say "Was that the doorbell ringing?", or "We are sitting in a ring.".

(Judge: Repeat all the instructions, then Start the Time)
