

The Stick-Together-Team

Judge: Preparation:

Set up the room with the following materials

- 5 5' Pieces of Duct Tape
- 5 pairs Scissors

Setup:

- 5 "Workstations" spread around the edges room – a desk and chair (or in adjacent rooms)
- Place 1 piece of duct tape and one pair of scissors at each "Workstation"
- A table or desk in the center of the room

Judge Instructions:

(Judge: When team members enter the room, tell them)

This is a hands-on verbal challenge. You have 1 minute to select the five team members who will compete. The others must sit in these seats and watch or be escorted from the room. They may not assist in solving the problem and may not talk.

(Judge: After 5 Team Members Chosen and seated, Read all the instructions, repeat, then Start the Time)

This is a four(4) part problem. Your challenge is to create a representation of the "Stick-Together-Team". The "Stick-Together-Team" will include five(5) creatures constructed entirely out of Duct Tape. Each Team member will create one creature at one of the Workstations around the room.

Part 1 – 2 Minutes

You may plan your solution in the center of the room. You may not touch or alter the Duct Tape during this period.

Part 2 – 4 Minutes

Each team member will go to a single Workstation and construct a single creature using only the Duct Tape. You may not talk to each other during this period and must stay near your particular Workstation.

Part 3 – 3 Minutes

You will arrange the creatures in a scene on the center table and create a presentation. The presentation will describe the creatures and why the creatures should win a "Stick-Together-Team Award".

Part 4 – 1 Minute

You will present the presentation. The presentation may be given by a single spokesperson, all or several members of the team

- 1-5 points for the quality of each of the 5 creatures
- 1-10 points for the creativity of each of the 5 creatures
- 1-25 points for the creativity and overall effect of the scene
- 1-25 points for the creativity and overall effect of the presentation
- 1-10 points for teamwork

You may ask questions at any time, time continues

(Judge: Repeat all the instructions, then Start the Time)
