Judge: Preparation:

- Set a table with five chairs for competing team members.
 - Provide a copy of the problem instructions on the table for the team members.
 - Create 31 cards, each with one of the following words:
 - Orange, purple, pink, north, hill, down
 - House, spoon, kitchen, tire, string, garage
 - Grass, painting, tree, corner, edge, basket
 - Duck, lion, bicycle, airport, lemon, potato
 - Monday, washing, run, walk, scream, mustard, loud
 - Cards face down on the table
-

Judge Instructions:

(Judge: When team members enter the room, tell them)

This is a verbal problem. You have 1 minute to select the five team members who will compete. The others must sit in these seats and watch or be escorted from the room. They may not assist in solving the problem and may not talk.

(Judge: After 5 Team Members Chosen and seated, Read all the instructions, repeat, then Start the Time)

1. You will have 1 minute to think and 4 minutes to respond. You may ask questions; however, time will continue. Do not talk to each other at any time
2. Once time begins, it will not be stopped, even if a judge asks you to repeat a response, clarify it, or give a more appropriate response. Speak loudly and clearly.
3. Your team will respond in the order that you are seated. You may not skip your turn, repeat an answer or pass.
4. On the table in front of you are 31 cards, each with one word facing down.
5. When time begins, the Judge will start a story with one line. And you will respond in order by picking a card, looking at the card and using the word on the card to continue the story.
6. You will receive 1 point for each response that continues the story, 3 points for each response that continues the story and moves it in a different direction, and 5 points for each response that continues the story, moves it in a different direction and is highly creative. If you turn over more than one card, or turn over a card out of turn or before your turn, it will be removed and will not be available for scoring.
7. For instance if the Judge turned over a card with the word birthday, the Judge might say: "Last week we went to a surprise birthday party".

(Judge: Repeat all the instructions, then Start the Time)
