## CTOM SPON ZONE Problem Hard Harder Hardest

## Judge: Preparation:

- Set a table with five chairs for competing team members.
- Provide a copy of the problem instructions on the table for the team members.

(Judge: 1. All individuals competing in this problem must be from the same team. 2. You cannot comment at the end of the problem on any of the responses or how they were scored.)

## Judge Instructions:

(Judge: When team members enter the room, tell them)

This is a verbal challenge. You have 1 minute to select the five team members who will compete. The others must sit in these seats and watch or be escorted from the room. They may not assist in solving the problem and may not talk.

(Judge: After 5 Team Members Chosen and seated, Read all the instructions, repeat, then Start the Time)

- 1. You will have 2 minutes to think and 3 minutes to respond. You may ask questions; however, time will continue. Do not talk to each other at any time
- 2. Once time begins, it will not be stopped, even if a judge asks you to repeat a response, clarify it, or give a more appropriate response. Speak loudly and clearly.
- 3. Your team will respond in the order that you are seated. You may not skip your turn, repeat an answer or pass. If one member of your team is stuck, then the others must wait for that team member to answer.
- 4. The 1<sup>st</sup> team member will respond with something that is hard. The 2<sup>nd</sup> team member will respond with two answers, something that is hard and something that is harder. The 3<sup>rd</sup> team member will respond with three answers, something that is hard, something that is harder, and something that is hardest. Then the 4<sup>th</sup> team member will provide a single answer that is hard, the 5<sup>th</sup> hard and hard, the 1<sup>st</sup> hard, harder, hardest and so on until time is up.
- 5. For instance the 1<sup>st</sup> team member might say "getting up on time is hard". The 2nd might say "walking to the beach is hard, walking back from the beach is harder". The 3<sup>rd</sup> might say "falling asleep is hard, counting sheep is harder, counting sleep is hardest"
- 6. You will receive 1 point for each single response, 2 points for each double response if the two responses are related otherwise 1 point, and 3 point s for each triple response if the responses are related or 1 point if they are not, each single creative response will receive 3 points, each double creative response will receive 5 points, and each triple creative response will receive 7 points.

(Judge: Repeat all the instructions, then Start the Time)
