## Roll Derby

## Judge: Preparation:

- You will need a smooth floor at least 30' from a wall
- Starting at the wall place 2' wide strips of tape, parallel to the wall at the following distances from the wall: 3', 2', 3', 2', 20', 30' Mark the areas A, B, C, D, E so the team can read the letters

3'	2'	3'	2'	10'	10'

Provide the following materials on a table for the team members in side area F

- Yardstick
- Board, 4' x 6"
  Three rolls toilet paper
- Three roles of duct tape

- Three rolls masking tape
- toilet paper Three
- Three roles cellophane tape

## Judge Instructions:

(Judge: When team members enter the room, tell them)

This is a hands-on challenge. You have 1 minute to select the five team members who will compete. The others must sit in these seats and watch or be escorted from the room. They may not assist in solving the problem and may not talk.

(Judge: After 5 Team Members Chosen and seated, Read all the instructions, repeat, then Start the Time)

On the floor we have marked off six areas A, B, C, D, E, F.

- Your task, is to roll rolls down the yardstick or the board and have them come to rest in areas B, C, and D.
- Team members, the yardstick, and the board must at all times remain in area F.
- One team member must hold up the yardstick or the board and another team member release a roll.
- The roll must be release near the top of the yardstick or board such that it rolls at least 2' down the board or the yardstick.

(Judge: demonstrate holding the board on an incline and releasing a roll down it, toward the wall)

You will have 5 minutes to practice. You will have 3 minutes to roll each object down the yardstick or the board

Scoring

- Each object rolled down the board will receive 3 points if it rests in area B or D, and 5 points if it rests in area C.
- Each object rolled down the yardstick will receive 4 points if it rests in area B or D, and 7 points if it rests in area C.
- For every error in a count 5 points will be deducted.
- At the end of the five minutes, each item not filled in on the Count Form 30 points will be deducted.
- You may have a negative score.

You may ask questions at any time, time continues.

(Judge: Repeat all the instructions, then Start the Time)

On the floor we have marked off six areas A, B, C, D, E, F.

Scoring

- Each object rolled down the board will receive 3 points if it rests in area B or D, and 5 points if it rests in area C.
- Each object rolled down the yardstick will receive 4 points if it rests in area B or D, and 7 points if it rests in area C.
- For every error in a count 5 points will be deducted.
- At the end of the five minutes, each item not filled in on the Count Form 30 points will be deducted.
- You may have a negative score.

(Judge: Repeat all the instructions, then Start the Time)
